ENGAGEMENT

ANNUAL COUNCIL SUMMIT:

- In-person or virtual convening (ideally at ASRM or as an additional event before/after Night of Hope) to share impact, hear from RESOLVE leadership, showcase member leadership, and foster collaboration across the industry. Participation at the Council Summit is limited to the C-Suite level.

QUARTERLY MEMBER BRIEFINGS:

- Regular briefings on legislative progress, community needs, and upcoming campaigns; opportunities for members to share insights on market trends and emerging patient needs. Participation in member briefings will vary by topic (e.g., marketing teams for patient education, government affairs teams on advocacy).

SPOTLIGHT RECOGNITION:

- Featuring Corporate Council members during National Infertility Awareness Week and other flagship events, highlighting their leadership, innovation, and contributions to access.

ADVISORY INPUT:

- Structured opportunities for members—individually and collectively—to provide input on family building policy, employer benefits trends, patient education, and other initiatives where Corporate perspective strengthens RESOLVE's work.

IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS

RESOLVE is pleased to accept in-kind contributions toward Corporate Council membership. Agreed-upon in-kind projects (e.g., pro bono consulting, marketing support, hosted events, technology or platform support, or other specialized services) will be valued as monetary contributions that support RESOLVE's mission and growth. The minimum in-kind contribution is \$5,000 and may be counted toward the Innovator level or above, depending on its value. Equity contributions may also be considered for the Innovator tier.
